Arlington National Cemetery Entrance Procedure

Hours: April - September 0800 - 1900 - 0800 - 1700 (other months) - Open 365 days per year.

- 1. Park at the paid parking lot (The first 30 minutes is free.)
- 3. Upon entering the facility, turn immediately right as you approach the information desk.
- 4. Ask one of the attendants at the registry desk to give you a pass for the cemetery indicating the graves you will visit.
- 5. Proceed back to the parking lot and give the parking lot attendant your stamped parking ticket. (You have 30 minutes from the time the ticket was issued to return it in order to avoid paying the parking fee).
- 6. Place your cemetery pass on your windshield inside your vehicle so it can be seen.
- 7. Upon exiting the parking lot, turn left to drive through security show them the permit).
- 8. The North gate is to your right. The South gate is to your left. The Women's Memorial is straight ahead.
- 9. Turn right to go to the only grave that is on the south side of the cemetery, MSqt Dilbri.
- 10. Start at Lot 54 (North side) and move clockwise as the lots are printed on the hand-out to make the most efficient use of time.
- 11. Follow the exit signs to exit the cemetery. Discard the pass. It is valid for the entire day.

<u>Preparation</u>: Rubber mallet (easiest to drive flag poles in the ground), heavy duty shoes (some graves (Rasmussen) will have soggy ground) bottled water. This takes several hours to visit all graves.





North Gate - Arlington National Cemetery
