## WHAT WE DO

- Provide visitation and support to critically wounded and seriously ill Security Forces Airmen who are 'med-evaced' to Walter Reed Bethesda Hospital in Maryland.
- Globally administer Security Forces recognition on the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial and Law Enforcement Officers Museum (NLEOM) in Washington DC. As of 2025, Eagle Chapter has aided SF units with adding 29 of the 46 Defenders (63%) - all since 2018 - to the Memorial.
- During National Police Week, place an Eagle Chapter wreath and a memorial sign at the National LE Officers Memorial in Washington DC for all of the Defenders added to the memorial.
- Aid Security Forces Airmen and families through donations to Security Force Booster and Key Spouse Clubs: Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling Washington DC, Dover Air Force Base DE, and Joint Base Langley-Eustis VA.
- Host SF Fallen Defenders Families reception luncheon (and provide \$1,000.00 monetary assistance with travel) for families that attend NLEOM formal dedication of their loved ones name in Washington DC.
- Partner with the National Park Service to annually host Vietnam War Veterans Memorial Wall Wash in Washington DC.
- Annually recognize the heroic Battle of
